Event Description:	<p>Energy Career Days is an event for high school students, grades 10-12, to explore the various areas of the electrical energy industry – generation, transmission, distribution. Activities such as operating heavy equipment, wearing & operating lineman safety equipment, cable pulling contest, designing a simple electrical system, making a termination or splice, solving a dispatching problem, reading a meter, figuring a utility bill, inspecting a pole, and operating a vehicle GIS computer offer students a glimpse of the diversity of careers in the industry.</p> <p>Small groups of students are escorted by industry volunteers who serve as a source of information about the industry as well as guides to the activities.</p> <p>Energy Career Days will be in conjunction with Colorado Construction Career Days which has been successful and growing for the past six years. Last year there were 1700 students and administrators in attendance from 76 schools in 32 districts</p>
